Offering an abbreviated parade route and judging categories more suited for even the smallest of tykes, the Strawberry Festival Junior Parade is the perfect opportunity for the youth in our community to get involved and be the stars of their very own parade! We would also like to invite businesses, organizations, clubs, etc. that relate children to participate.

Parade Categories

Entries will be judged according to their originality, effort of construction, and interpretation of the year's theme ("Strawberry Vacation"). The categories for entries are:

- 1) Wheels/Walkers
- 2) Animals
- 3) Floats
- 4) School
- 5) Church
- 6) Club/Team
- 7.) Business/Organization

Parade Route

From the staging area along Rose Street—including the Boys and Girls Club, the parade moves East along Rose St. before turning **South on Main St.** The parade proceeds on Main St., running through the heart of downtown, before turning West on Maple St. The parade will officially disband at Maple and Second St. Popsicles will be passed out near the parade terminus.

Popsicles

As a reward for their efforts, participants will receive popsicles afterward, compliments of Adam Kirkpatrick and distributed by Strawberry Festival's Senior Court Princesses! Popsicles will be handed out at the end of the parade.

Registration

Registration forms must be signed by a parent or legal guardian to be eligible for participation in the Junior Parade.

Rules

- NO motorized vehicles are allowed in the parade with the exception of those used for pulling floats, and must be driven by a licensed adult driver. Power Wheels may be driven by participants if accompanied by an adult.
- Power wheels will be allowed if accompanied by an adult.
- **NOTHING** may be tossed or projected from participants to spectators. Flyers and candy may be gently handed out.
- All participants shall have turned in a completed registration form signed by a parent or legal guardian.

- 1) All entries must check in at the registration table located at 5th and Rose St (Boys & Girls Club) upon arrival
- 2) Registration forms must be signed by a parent/legal guardian to be able to participate.
- 3) Staging will begin at 12:00 pm, judging will be from 1:00 – 2:00 pm, and the parade will start at 2:30 pm.
- 4) Judges will consider originality, construction effort, and individual theme incorporation. Awards will be given in the following categories; Best use of Theme, Best use of Music, Queen Choice, and Mayor Choice.
- 5) NOTHING may be thrown, tossed, or otherwise projected into the spectators. This is strictly prohibited by law, and is essential for the safety of our spectators.
- 6) NO motorized vehicles are allowed in the parade with the exception of those used for pulling floats, and must be driven by a licensed adult driver. Power Wheels may be driven by participants if accompanied by an adult.
- 7) Judging will be in the following categories: Wheels/Walkers. Animals, Floats, School, Church, Club/Team, Business/Organization.

4. Please stay in your category's area—judging will be taking place and you do not want to miss your opportunity to be included.
5. Restrooms will be available near the registration table.
6. Please try to pre-register, this will save time and confusion for everyone.
